DELAY TRIAL OF NOTED SURGEON

GREENSBORO, N. C., Feb. 28—(ANP)—The
Dr. Charles C. Stewart, prominent North Carolina surgeon,
charged with second degree murder, was postponed
this week.

Dr. Stewart was charged with first degree murder
connection with the death of Ethel
Smith, white, in which he is alleged
to have performed an illegal oper-
ation, but only a day before the
trial was changed to second degree
murder and the medic was admit-
ted to \$5,000 bail.

The trial was postponed at the

request of the State's counsel,
stated that one of their counsel-
ness was ill. A postponement

a week was granted. The
counsel stated that they were
for trial.
